PREFACE

According to historical account the first Canadian census was initiated in 1666 by Jean Baptiste Talon (1625-1694), appointed Intendant of New France. Talon is considered "the father of modern census in Canada", because his enumeration reported 3,215 inhabitants, the basic resources and needs of the colonies and commenced the practice of taking future census on a regular basis.

Before 1841, there was no statute passed in many Canadian provinces for taking census regularly. Various attempts were made on an irregular basis, in Nova Scotia (1811, 1817, 1827, and 1828) and in Quebec (1825 and 1831).

In Upper Canada (Ontario) there was from 1793 (3 George III, C2) a series of ordinances or statutes requiring the taking of a census every year, starting with "a true and complete list of every male and female" resident in each district but later reverting to a nominal listing of the heads of households. Some of these listings have survived the passing of time. By 1851, the custom of taking the names of family members every ten years was established. By 1867, the taking of the census became a constitutional requirement in the formation of the country of Canada by the union of Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, Quebec and Ontario. In 1871, the first Dominion census was conducted and the County of Brant Census was transcribed by the heads of households in hard copy and published by The Ontario Genealogical Society.

The following census of 1824, 1827, 1829 and 1832 were transcribed from Reels 11 and 12, Gore District, Grand River Tract, Haldimand Township (later Brantford Township, Brant County) at the Kitchener Public Library, 85 Queen Street North, Kitchener, Ontario N2H 2H1. In 1816, the Gore District was formed and Dumfries Townships, Brantford Township and Tuscarora Township (Six Nations Reservation) became part of the Gore District. Burford Township and Oakland Township became part of the Brock District.

It was difficult to decipher the names of the household heads due to variations in spelling and faded entries. The settlement of people on the Grand River Tract increases in the 1820's and 1830's due to the sale of Indian lands.

From the book "Sketches of Upper Canada," by John Howison, Esq. of the Honourable East India Company's Service, 1825 (p. 160-161). The following description is about life on the Grand River:

"The Grand River is navigable for schooners thirty miles above its mouth, and for large boats much farther. This is a circumstance of great importance, as its banks abound with beds of gypsum, or sulphate of lime, which has been found to form an excellent manure. These are not regularly worked by anyone at present, therefore the farmers who require gypsum must quarry and convey it down the Grand River themselves; and this being always troublesome and often inconvenient, the mineral is much less employed in agriculture than it ought to be. The sulphate of lime forms a very powerful manure. Two bushels are sufficient for an acre when properly applied, and the effect produced by these continues at least a couple of years. It differs altogether in its action from common lime, being particularly suitable for light sandy soils that have been exhausted by a repetition of the same kind of crops.

Gypsum will soon be in great demand throughout the western parts of the Province; for many of the older farms are nearly worn out, in consequence of the injudicious system pursued by those who cultivate them. The farmers have little idea of the rotation of crops; either do they endeavour to keep the soil rich and vigorous, by the timely application of manure. Corn succeeds corn, until the land is nearly exhausted, which generally happens in the course of eighteen or twenty years, - a length of time which alike prove its natural excellence and shows that, under proper management, its fertility would for ages remain unimpaired. The finest and most extensive bed of gypsum that has yet been discovered lies in the township of Dumfries, which belongs to William Dickson, Esq. This gentleman liberally permits the farmer to quarry and carry away as much of the mineral, as they please, free of expense".

On April 13, 1830, an agreement was prepared whereby for the sum of five shillings, of the lawful money of Upper Canada, an estimated area of 807 acres for the village site of Brantford was purchased. The document was signed by the following Sachems and Chiefs: Jacob Ayonghwahtha, Henry Brant Dekonagwasen, Jacob Shoriahowane, Lawrence Tharon-tenh-tha, Icak Teghennakarine, Moses Shohsgoarowane, Joseph Dwaserage, Peter Kanongwaheye, Otatseghte, Wagerieyos, Awennoxsonton, Teghatkahtos, Skanawatigh, Oneschazen, Skayentaken, Oghnawara, Oghrenhregowa, Kannehdage, Kanougeritawi, Kanayegh, Dekenyough, Dewatiron, Deyotoreghgon, Skawenatigh,

Kahwisdanero, Dekawahgwen, Dayekaweke, Kayonanoran, Teatup, and Henry A. Hill.

The delivery of the deed of the site of the village was made in the presence of John Brant (1794-1832), youngest son of Chief Joseph Brant, then Superintendent of the Six Nation Indians; William Holme, Justice of the Peace; James Racey, Justice of the Peace; Lewis Burwell, the first land surveyor to settle in the area; and John Norton, friend and trader with the Indians.






